

Examples of Desiderat. verbs from LSJ (1940).

ἀγορασεῖω, Desid. of ἀγοράζω, wish to buy, Sch.Ar.Ra.1068.

ἀκουσεῖω [α[^]], Desiderat. of ἀκούω, long to hear, S.Fr.991; and in Hsch. the order of words requires ἀκουσεῖων for ἀκουσιῶν.

ἀναγνωσεῖω, Desiderat. of ἀναγιγνώσκω, wish to read, Gloss.

ἀναστησεῖω, Desiderat. of ἀνίσταμαι, Agath.3.4.

ἀπαλλαξεῖω, Desiderat. of ἀπαλλάσσομαι, wish to be delivered from or get rid of, “τινός” Th.1.95,3.84, Procop.Arc.4.

ἀποδωσεῖω, Desiderat., wish to give back, Procop.Goth.3.34.

βρωσεῖω, Desiderat. of βιβρώσκω, to be hungry, Call.Fr.435.

βινητιᾶω, Desiderat. of βινέω, coire cupio, of the woman, Ar.Lys. 715, Machoap.Ath.13.583c; of the man, Luc.Pseudol.27.

γάμῃσεῖω, Desiderat. of γαμέω, wish to marry, Alciphr.1.13, 3.37.

διαβάσεῖω, Desiderat. of διαβαίνω, D.C.40.32.

γελασεῖω, Desiderat. of γελάω, to be ready to laugh, Pl.Phil. 64b.

δρασεῖω, Desiderat. of δράω, have a mind to do, S.Aj.326,585, E. Ph.1208, Med.93, Ar.Pax62.

ἐλασεῖω, (ἐλαύνω) Desiderat., wish to march, Luc.Cont.9.

κατηγορησεῖω, Desiderat., to be anxious to accuse, Agath.4.2.

ἐνδωσεῖω, to be inclined to yield, D.C.46.37 (cj.), Agath.1.9.

θυσεῖω, Desiderat. of θύω, Hdn.Epim.249.

κλαυσιᾶω, Desider. of κλαίω, wish to weep, τὸ θύριον φθεγγόμενον ἄλλως κ. the door is like to weep, i.e. shall suffer for creaking, Ar.Pl. 1099.

κνησιᾶω, Desider. of κνάω, desire to scratch, itch, Ar.Ec.919 (lyr.), Pl.Grg.494c, 494e, Jul.Or.7.206d.

μαθητιᾶω, Desiderat. wish to become a disciple, wish to learn, Ar.Nu.183, Ps.- Luc.Philopat.14, AP15.38 (Cometas).

μελλητιᾶω, Desiderat. from μέλλω, wish to delay, Hsch.

ναυμαχησεῖω, Desiderat. of ναυμαχέω, wish to fight by sea, Th.8.79.

οὐρητιᾶω, Desiderat. of οὐρέω, Ar.V.807, Arist.Pr.878b33.

παραδωσεῖω, Desiderat. of παραδίδωμι, to be disposed to deliver up, Th.4.28 (fort. -δοο-, cf. συμβασεῖω).

πελασεῖω, Desiderat. of “πελάζω, τῆ πολιορκίᾳ” Agath.3.21.

ποιησεῖω, Desiderat. of ποιέω, desire to do, Hdn.Epim.249.

πολεμησεῖω, Desiderat. of πολεμέω, Th.1.33, D.C.46.30.

προδωσεῖω, Desiderat. of προδίδωμι, wish to betray, “προδωσειόντι ἔοικε” Dam.Isid.173.

στρατευσεῖω, Desiderat. to be anxious for war, D.C.53.25, Fr.40.33.

συμβασεῖω, Desiderat. of “συμβαίνω”, wish to make a league or covenant, Th.8.56.

τιμωρησεῖω, wish to avenge, “-ησειόντες” Agath.3.17.

τυραννησεῖω, Desiderat. of τυραννέω, aspire to sovereignty, Sol. ap. D.L.1.65.

φευκτιᾶω, Desiderat. from φεύγω, wish to flee, Arist.Fr.130.

χεζητιᾶω, Desiderat. of χέζω, want to ease oneself, Ar.Nu.1387, Ra.8, al.

χειρονομησεῖω, Desiderat., wish to gesticulate, Cratin. 453.

χεσεῖω, Desiderat. of χέζω, Ar.Eq.888, Nu.295 (anap.).

ὠνησεῖω, Desiderat. of ὠνόμομαι, wish to buy, D.C.47.14.
